

CPC10111 Certificate I in Construction

Details

The CPC10111 Certificate I in Construction qualification is an introductory course to the construction industry for a person with no previous connection to the construction industry or relevant employment history. This course will provide an introduction to the construction industry's culture, occupations, job roles and workplace expectations, and will cover essential work health and safety requirements.

The course contains eight (8) core units of competency that are:

- CPCCCM1012A Work effectively and sustainably in the construction industry
- CPCCCM1013A Plan and organise work
- CPCCCM1014A Conduct workplace communication
- CPCCCM2001A Read and interpret plans and specifications
- CPCCCM2005B Use construction tools and equipment
- CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry
- CPCCOHS2001A Apply OHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry
- CPCCVE1011A Undertake a basic construction project

PLUS three (3) elective units of competency that are:

- CPCCCM2004A Handle construction materials
- CPCCCM2006B Apply basic levelling procedures
- RIIWHS204D Work safely at heights OR RIIMPO301D Conduct hydraulic excavator operations*
