

## Standard 11 Induction (RIISS00034 Surface Coal Mine Safety Skill Set)

### Details

The RIISS00034 Surface Coal Mine Safety Skill Set is required for open-cut mining and is recognised as Standard 11, Training in coalmines – Coal Mining Safety and Health Act, Queensland. This Skill Set is recommended for individuals working in surface coal mining operations in the Resources and Infrastructure Industry.

The Skill Set contains six (6) units of competency that are:

- RIIERR302D Response to local emergencies and incidents
- RIICOM201D Communicate in the workplace
- RIIWHS201D Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures
- RIIRIS201D Conduct local risk control
- RIIGOV201D Comply with site work processes/procedures
- RIIERR205D Apply initial first aid
