

TLI21315 Certificate II in Rail Infrastructure

Details

The TLI21315 Certificate II in Rail Infrastructure qualification is a general qualification for a person engaged in basic operations within the rail infrastructure environment, undertaking a range of tasks involving known routines and procedures and taking some responsibility for the quality of work outcomes.

The course contains seven (7) core units of competency that are:

- TLIB1028 Maintain and use hand tools
- TLID1001 Shift materials safely using manual handling methods
- TLIE1003 Participate in basic workplace communication
- TLIF1001 Follow work health and safety procedures
- TLIF2010 Apply fatigue management strategies
- TLIF2080 Safely access the rail corridor
- TLIU2008 Apply environmental procedures to rail infrastructure

PLUS six (6) specialist Track Work units of competency that are:

- TLIB2085 Apply track fundamentals
- TLIB2092 Operate minor mechanical equipment
- TLIS2030 Carry out track ballasting
- TLIS2031 Install railway sleepers
- TLIS2034 Install and repair rail fastening systems
- TLIS2044 Carry out rail installation

PLUS three (3) general units of competency that are:

- TLIW2001 Operate under track protection rules
- TLIB2121 Maintain rail joints
- TLIB2097 Install and maintain rail guards

Duration/Delivery Mode

Course duration: This course will take 600 hours - up to a maximum of 6 months
Delivery mode: Blended - Face-to-face classroom with practical in a simulated rail work environment

Students must meet the following criteria:

- Not hold a Certificate III qualification or higher (other than school based traineeship)

Must be 15 years or older and no longer at school
