

RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations

Details

The RII30115 Certificate III in Surface Extraction Operations qualification reflects the role of individuals who perform tasks in an open cut mine or quarry.

The course contains three (3) core units of competency that are:

- RIIENV201D Identify and assess environmental and heritage concerns
- RIIRIS301D Apply risk management processes
- RIIWHS201D Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures

PLUS ten (10) elective units of competency that are:

- *MSAPMPER300C Issue work permits
- RIIRIS202D Respond to site based spills

- *RIIRIS201B Conduct local risk control
- RIIWHS204D Work safely at heights
- **RIISAM301E Test operational functions of vehicles and equipment OR RIIMPO301D Conduct hydraulic excavator operations
